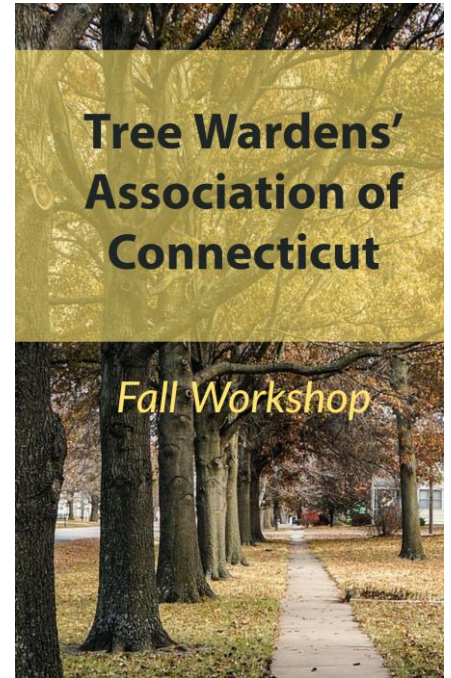

Compacted soils, air pollution, salt runoff and spray, heat island effect, and more can compromise a tree's ability to ward off biotic stressors like insects, fungi, and bacteria. Also, the trees we manage are usually the first to be threatened by a new pest or disease because the pathogens are often introduced through urban areas. In this session we will examine biotic and abiotic problems that affect our trees and explore ways and means to counteract them and help trees to not only survive, but also thrive.
